

**Closing Week-end Schedule:**

***HMS Pinafore!* Thurs., Fri., Sat., Nights at 8 p.m. in the Opera House – Parents night is Sat., Aug 14.**

**Friday August 13**– Camper banquet at dinner 5 p.m., all campers required. Campers to operetta at 8 p.m. Cast at opera house by 6:30 p.m.

**Saturday August 14** – Clinic and exhibition for parents: 9:30 a.m. Grant Field  
12:30-2 p.m. Picnic Lunch – Dining Hall for parents and children

**Afternoon Activities:**

Parent- Child Tennis Round Robin at tennis courts w/Coach Aronson and staff after lunch – circa 2 p.m.

Walk/jog “High Noon” course – 12:00 (It is a High Noon, after all), after Clinic – meet at office. Anywhere from 1-2 miles.

After lunch - Boat/Swim at waterfront w/waterfront staff (canoes, kayaks, sunfish, or swim **in swim area** under supervision of waterfront staff – no power boating or skiing please!) **Life jackets required for all boating activities.**

**5 p.m. Sat. dinner:** Beachfront will be available for BYO dinner. We will provide grill, you provide all else. We will help transport you and your food, etc. to the beach from the top of the hill. Please leave your cars up there.

**If your son is flying, be sure we have his flight info so we get him to the airport. Fee is \$45 for Manchester, \$80 for Boston. Checks payable to “Camp Tecumseh”. Our vans to the airport will leave after closing ceremonies on Sunday at 10:30 and it takes us 1 ¼ hours to Manchester and 2 ½ hours to Boston so please schedule flights accordingly and allow an hour to check in.**
