The campaign seeks to preserve the physical campus, add quality to our time-proven programs by attracting and maintaining the finest staff possible, and create an endowed fund for financial aid and scholarships. ENDOWMENT OF FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Each summer, about 15% of families receive some form of financial assistance that makes Tecumseh a reality, and the Trustees are committed to maintaining the diversity of Tecumseh's enrollment which helps to make every camper stronger and better-rounded.
